2. Finance and Membership Report	Robert Hasserjian	SH Financial Statements, including Balance Sheet, Results of Operations, and Revenues/Expenses as of 2/28/19 were presented. The total net assets as of 2/28/19 were \$248,358, with revenue of \$66,803 and 3expenses of \$58,821 over the period of 3/1/2018-2/28/2019. Income and expenses fluctuate over years due to timing of when the expenses were reported; average annual expenses for 2015-2018 are \$70,000. WHO Funds as of 2/28/19 were \$367,594 Member dues income increased from \$47,603 (3/1/17-2/28/18) to \$65,150 (3/1/18-2/28/19). Total membership as of 2/28/19 was 523, representing an increase increased from 398 in the prior year. Expenses were as expected.	
3. 2018 Scientific Symposium	Robert Hasserjian	The 2018 Scientific Symposium was “New and Updated Entities in the Revised WHO Classification”. It received 91% positive evaluations, with overall rating of 4.6 out of 5.
